




We will be:

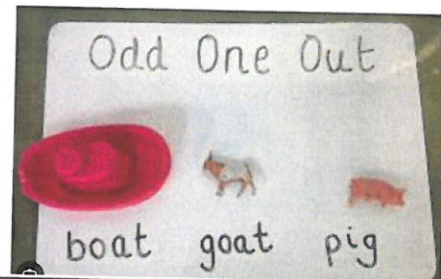
- Noticing and talking about numerals in the environment
