Phonics Phase 1 Aspect 4 – Rythm & Rhyme

- Singing familiar nursery rhymes and making up some of our own.
- Identifying words that rhyme in both songs and stories.

- Exploring what happens to powder snow when we add water.
- Using paint brushes and paint to make intentional marks.
- Exploring why the polar bear felt lonely in the book "The Polar Bear and the Snow Cloud" and talking about what we could do if we were feeling that way.
