

- Talking about how we travel to school and recording this information on a tally chart and pictogram.



Phonics Phase 1 Aspect 5 – Alliteration

We will be:


- Learning that alliteration is when different words start with the same sound or letter.
- Playing games and saying lots of silly sentences with the aim that children hear that repeated sounds are happening.
