

Maths

We will be:

- Continuing to work on our subitising to three, four or five.
- Re-visiting our knowledge of ABAB patterns using two coloured counters/cubes.
- Some of us will take this concept further by making a repeating ABAB patterns using 2D shapes (all same colour) e.g circle, triangle, circle, triangle etc.



Phonics Phase 1 Aspect 4 - Rythm & Rhyme

We will be:

- Clapping out the syllables in children's names like "Ol-iver" = three claps or familiar words, such as "el-ephant."
- Singing Nursery rhymes with a steady beat and marching to that beat. We will be singing and marching to Horsey Horsey, The Grand Old Duke of York, Tick, Tock, Tick, Tock, I'm a Little Cuckoo Clock and Hickory Dickory Dock.





Learning opportunities:

- The children in Chestnut have been really interested in painting and making marks and patterns using paint. We will explore this further by making marks with paint using new tools and techniques such as dabbing with sponges.
- We will be drawing common 2D shapes on big rolls of paper to create their own enclosed shapes.
- We will be using 3D shapes to print into playdough.
